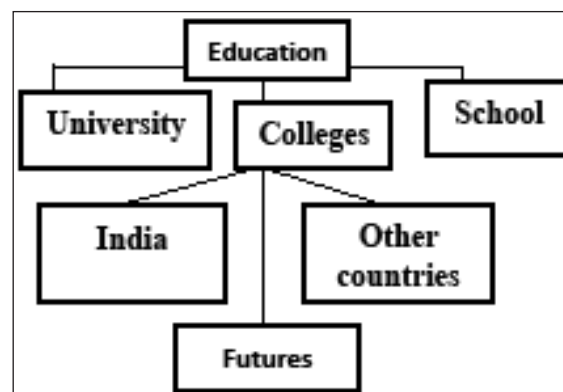

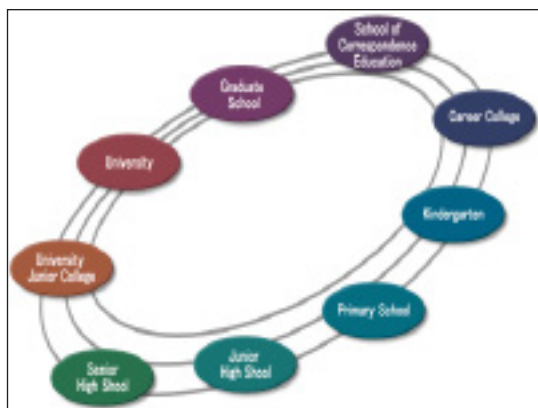


Fig. 1: Education System in Foreign Countries

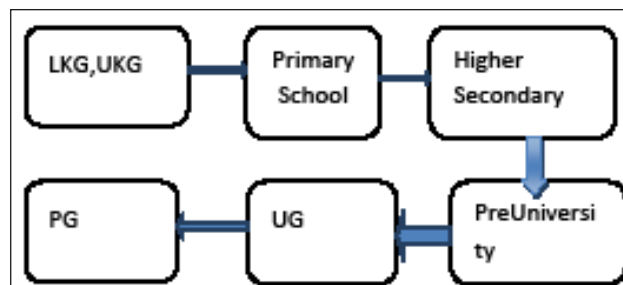


Fig. 2: Education System in India

studies.

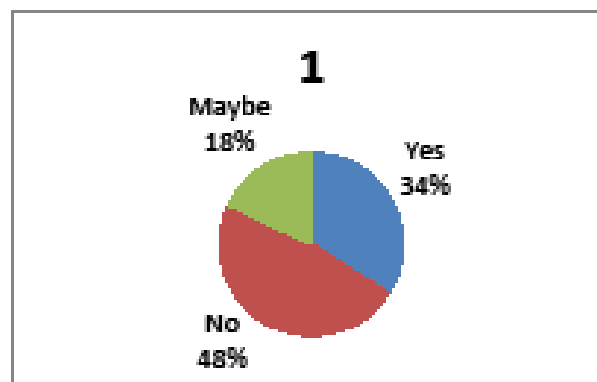


Fig. 1: Preference of Indian Higher Studies

This question reports that Indian education system is better than abroad education system.

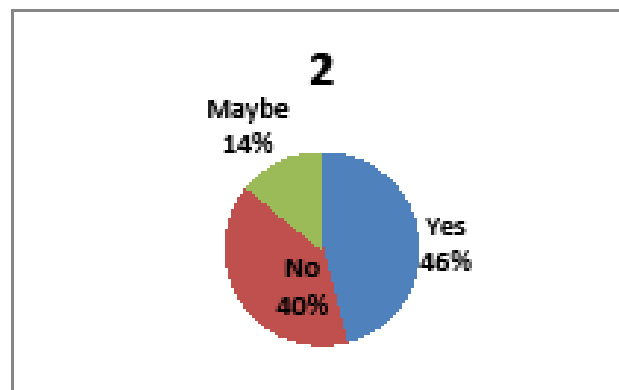


Fig. 2: Preference of Indian System

This question can conclude that the abroad educations are very costly than Indian education system.

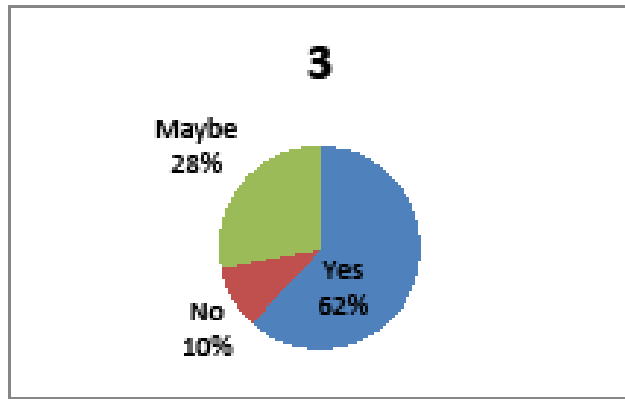


Fig. 3: Expensive Foreign System

This question can report that the students who done their higher studies in abroad are preferred mostly in all sectors.

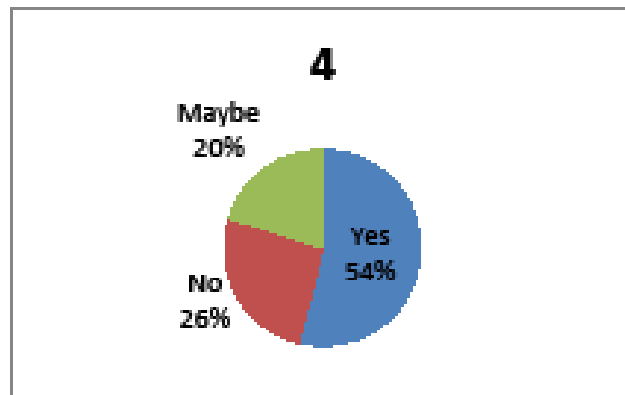


Fig. 4: Preference of Foreign Studies

This question reports that the students who are completed their higher studies in abroad have a better knowledge than the students who are completed in India.

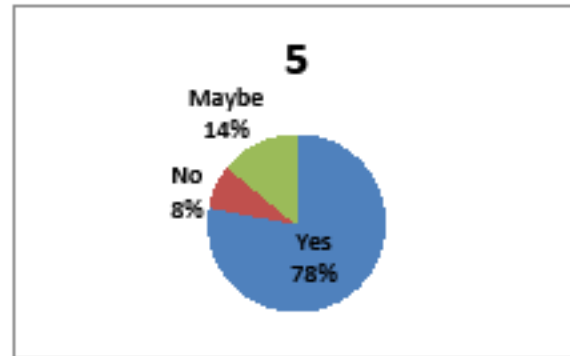


Fig. 5: Knowledge by Abroad Studies

This question reports that, the most of the students are preferred abroad only for studies and they will return back to India.

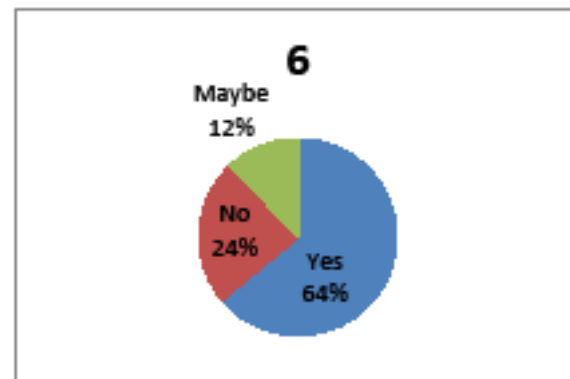


Fig. 6: Return Back

This question report that the most of the students want to return back to India to settle and the students prefers the abroad only for their higher studies and not to live.

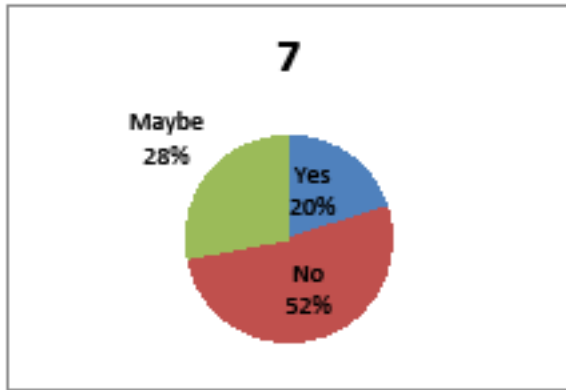


Fig. 7: Settle in Abroad

This question reports that studying in abroad can offer a right job in abroad. And it is easy to find a job with the qualification in abroad colleges and universities.

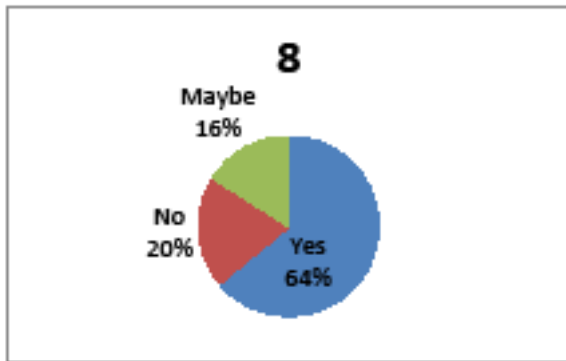


Fig. 8: About Job Finding

This question reports that, not only the abroad qualifications offer a right job. This question reflects that why Indians are preferred for more jobs in abroad.

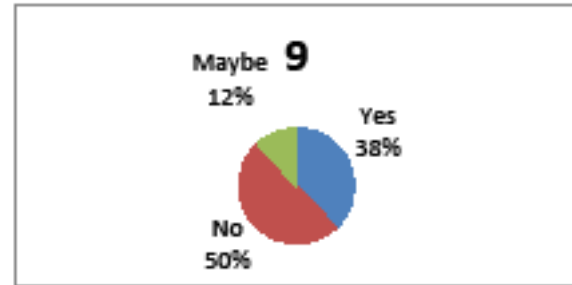


Fig. 9: Abroad Study is the Way to Get Abroad Job

This question reports that Indian education system is very easy and better than the other education system in abroad.

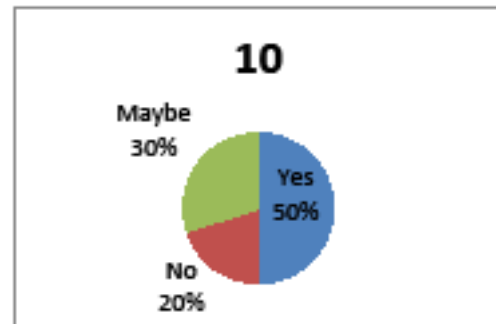


Fig. 10: Difficulty in Study
